### CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT JOFRED AVILES

CMSgt Jofred Aviles is the Senior Enlisted Leader, Headquarters, Readiness and Integration Organization (HQ RIO), Buckley Space Force Base, Colorado. He is the senior enlisted advisor to the HQ RIO commander and senior staff on all matters affecting operations, training and readiness, health, morale, welfare, and discipline for the Individual Reserve (IR) population. HQ RIO operates seven detachments and six operating locations at geographically separated units around the world. The HQ RIO and detachment full time staff of 143 Active Guard Reservists, civilian and contractor personnel assist in providing direct oversight and support to over 7,800 Individual Mobilization Augmentees and Participating Individual Ready Reservists to provide combat-ready Airmen to active component commanders across 53 separate organizations which include all Major Commands, Combatant Commands, and various government agencies.

Chief Aviles enlisted into the Air Force on 27 Jun 2006 as a Health Services Management Apprentice. Throughout his career, Chief Aviles has served in multiple capacities within the Health Services Management, Aerospace Medicine and Special Operations Support community.



Additionally, he served as the Command's Medical Staff Manager overseeing Credentialing and Privileging Administration Services for 63 Reserve Medical Units encompassing 2,106 providers. Prior to his current position, Chief Aviles was the Health Services Management, Medical Material, Biomedical Equipment and Mental Health Service MAJCOM Functional Manager where he oversaw internal policies and procedures while providing input on regulations governing AFSC-specific training four enlisted specialties encompassing over 1,600 personnel. Chief Aviles has deployed in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, INHERENT RESOLVE and DELIBERATE RESOLVE. His assignments include bases in Germany, Japan, Hawaii, California and Georgia.
