I'm guessing you were trying to add it to your March 2025 authorization. I went in to check and saw that 25 RIO AT OFF was available. So, I went ahead and added it. Does that resolve your question?
Does the Air Force Review board look for trends to identify if there might be a possible issue with a particular process/policy?	If the boards identify a trend they reach out to the policy owner.
Local CPTS for debt and not RIO RPO? Sometimes we have issues with base services helping IMAs	If the debt was as a result of IR status, the servicing pay office is RIO/RPO. Please keep in mind that if a debt originated from a different status, like TR, AGR, or active component, then RIO will typically defer to the servicing finance according to the members status.
I was recently told that I may be charged by TRICARE for receiving the annual Flu shot (IMR requirement) at an AD MTF. Truth?	You should not be billed for receiving your flu shot at the AD MTF.

Great Question, if you were an AGR or Title 10 Status while in the Guard you can apply to the remissions board. If you were a TR from the Guard to IMA then you would need to apply via the Debt waiver process.

Until then, you can upload blank documents in the required areas.</p>
<p>Hi, regarding LOD, does it automatically transfers to VA after 365 days or any action is required from the member to get it transferred?</p>	<p>It does not automatically transfer to the VA, this is something that would need to be initiated by the member to transfer and establish care at the VA</p>

Thanks!</p>	<p>If you are not a flyer, no in-person PHA is required</p>
<p>Hello, I just transferred to IMA last week and I don't have the notification on myVector to ACK the TASKORD. I completed the TASKORD ACK back when I was in a unit as an AGR a couple of months ago.</p>	<p>You weren't on the Nov alpha. You're good.</p>
<p>I'm a brand new IMA as of 8 Dec 24. I have been looking in MyVector but do not see the survey function. Are there instructions available so I can complete this requirement?</p>	<p>No acknowledgement required since you are a new IMA. However, you will still need to review thew TASKORD.</p>

What's happening to the 13S IMAs not picked up by Space Force? (I'm not a 13S, just wondering)	Those individuals will work with their Career Field Manager (CFM) to explore opportunities to stay in the AFR.
Have the initial pool of IMA billets that have been approved for realignment been communicated to the MA/RA and CFMs?	It will happen early next week.
Approx how many billets are you estimating will be realigned?	It is a very small number at this time.
Understanding this process will take time, how long do we anticipate the E-9 hiring freeze to remain in place?	We are working with the Command Chief's office and the Chief's Group to determine timelines for the E-9 hiring freeze
How are new "spaces" being advertised for IMA to apply for these new opportunities with the IR strategic alignment?	RMVS will continued to be used to advertise new opportunities.
Can we volunteer for the realignment if we are seeking a different IMA position?	This effort is focused on spaces and not faces. However if you're looking for a new IMA position I encourage you to check RMVS frequently
Ma'am - are there command-specific POCs for this realignment? I'm a new body with ICC(P), curious as to who is advising their processes.	We met with the Reserve ICC transition team earlier this week and are actively collecting requirements from the ICC

Also, when is the first stage of this occurring?	The assessment stage completed in Late October 2024.
When will the people in those billets be notified?	3Q. FY25
Add on to 13S questions, how about other AFSCs sitting on Space Force billets, like 62/63's?	Work with your CFM, Col Gary Frisard and Lt Col Shannon Walker to find new opportunities.
Are there going to be any new positions added as part of the strategic review?	We will realign existing positions to meet the new strategic priorities.
This reallocation is NOT synonymous with reduction in force, correct?	Correct. As the framework reflects, this is a strategic realignment of billets to ensure IMA billets are aligned to strategic priorities.
Good afternoon, I echo the question on the CMSgt hiring pause duration. We thought advertisements would occur in January per the REG Sharepoint site but were told via email that our E9 AFMC A4 position is still frozen and cannot be advertised in January. Is there a timeline for the freeze to thaw? Thanks!	We anticipate a memo this month that will share plans for 3Q FY25. We are also going to have a framework for Chief IMA billets that aligns to the latest framework for the portfolio. It's about deliberate management, thinking from a strategic/enterprise level and ensuring our billets are in the best places at the appropriate rank.
We're already tracking that USSF-assigned IMA billets will be defunded as the PMA is implemented in the coming FYs, but were any of these billets examine for the realignment effort, too?	We did acknowledge they were there. As Col Day is noting, the USSF transition is a separate effort.
Chief just made a statement that the PT test may be changing. How so?	We do not have any details yet.
Can you comment/will there be guidance on whether IMAs will continue to support USSF units for the duration of the interim? Given that the "part time" space force won't be ready until FY26	We are working that guidance now and will release as soon as we can.
Who can I contact to figure out what the LOA for Det 6 when completing DTS? Submitting for IDTs.	Det 6 can assist.

<p>We've been told AFRC has out a hiring freeze on the 13S career field. What resources or information does RIO have for affected members who work in Space, looking to PCS, and other career impacts in the interim because Space Force Part-time isn't slated to start until 2026.</p>	<p>Your 13S CFM is your best POC for exploring opportunities to continue your career.</p>
<p>BMI measurement was mentioned as a readiness item. My unit at USFK is not able to record my BMI measurement this year. Is there another way to record it?</p>	<p>The Body Composition Program is managed by your assigned organization. They should have the ability to update you in the myBodyComp app in myFSS.</p>
<p>There are still two wing-level "IMA to SEL" billets within OSI that are E-8 capped while all other similar billets are E-9. Will these realignments keep the current E-8 billets from being upgraded to E-9?</p>	<p>Great question...and not sure yet. We need to have more conversations.</p>
<p>How does that work? We won't know of future orders at that time</p>	<p>My assumption is that this question concerns leave carryover or sellback. If so, leave earned on an order stays associate with that specific order until it is either sold or carried over. So, if/when you begin a new order, you may begin the carryover process to that order. If you'd prefer to sell leave, you do not need a new order to do so.</p>
<p>Does SGLI apply if you die while not on orders?</p>	<p>Yes, if you are enrolled. The Casualty Assistance Rep can verify and walk surviving family members through the process for the death benefit claim.</p>
<p>So if we want to carry our leave over in the future, we have to make that decision as soon as our tour is over?</p>	<p>A1 pushed guidance, however, it's going to be rewritten because it conflicts with many other regs, to include the DoD FMR. More to follow concerning the guidance. Right now, RPO is NOT auto selling unused leave. RPO is processing according to the 1089 submitted by the member.</p>
<p>Is there messaging that can go out regarding change from 24 to 48 IDTs and vice versa? I've never heard that before and that's an important detail our IMAs need to know</p>	<p>Yes. We can add that to our RIO Buzz and other messaging. We are also working in-processing via the Dets to ensure the RPO is aware of these types of changes.</p>

For orders processing, specifically for MPA, our URCs want us to have our tours obligated before end of ths CY for FY25 orders. However, RIO policy for processing orders is 3-4 weeks before the tour.
