



To complete your Article 137 JAG Briefing, which is 47.52 minutes long:

1. You will log into myLearning with your CAC
2. Copy and paste this link into your browser: <https://lms-jets.cce.af.mil/moodle>
3. Select View All Courses



4. Under Search Courses Type Article 137 Briefing and hit the SEARCH icon



5. Select the Article 137 Briefing by clicking on the text




