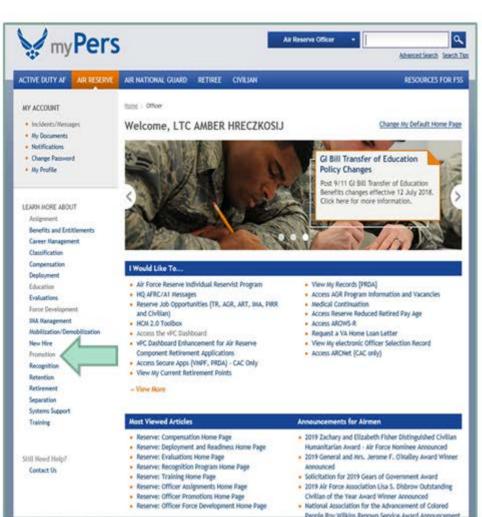


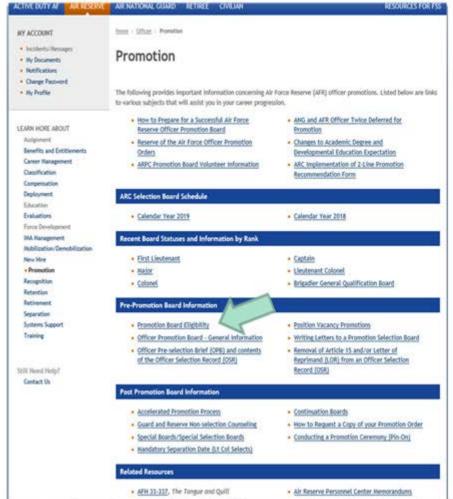

#### Officer Promotion Board Eligibility

#### Applicable to: Air National Guard & Air Force Reserve

A centralized selection board convenes in advance of completing time in grade [TIG] requirements and identifies officers who have demonstrated the potential to serve successfully in the next higher grade. To determine an officer's potential, the board is instructed to evaluate each of the eligible officers using the whole-person concept; the board considers an officer's demonstrated performance, breadth of experience, job responsibility, professional competence or job knowledge, specific achievements, developmental education, academic education (to the grade of Col only), leadership and Air National Guard (ANC) (Air Force Reserve (AFR) participation. A board member's accessment of potential is based solely on information documented in the efficier eslection record. Prior to meeting such a bound, the officer must meet certain eliability criteria.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Must be in active status in the ANG or AFR or in Individual Ready Reserve (IRIR) at the time of the board
- Must have one year on the Reserve Active Status List (RASL) or combination of RASL and Active Duty List (ADL) prior to the promotion board convene date.
   MOTE: IRR and Stand-by Reserve time counts as RASL time
- Officers with a pending retirement/separation within 90 days after board convene date will be deleted from the board
- TIG: for an estimated board projection (position acancy (PV) or mandatory) enter date of rank (DDR) into Promotion Calculate

  (PV) or Mandatory Promotion Calculator

  (PV) or Mandatory Promotion Calculator

Promotions under the PV program maintain a balance force by giving commanders the means to nominate exceptionally well qualified candidates for promotion to fill vacancies in the grades of captain through tieuterant colonel in the Air Force Reserve. For a PV promotion board the following additional factors are used for the officer to meet the heart:

- Only Selected Reserve officers are eligible for nomination (excludes LEAD and Cat-E)
- . Incumbent in higher graded position and nominated by senior rater
  - · Position must be funded one year after board convene date
  - · No overage code in MiIPDS
- Previous Retirement/Retention year (most recent to board convene date) must have at least 50 resets (satisfactors year)

Note 2: For ANG State Position Vacancy nominations (Maj and Lt Col) and ANG Cols Fed Rec Review board nominations, please check with your FSS and/or State Headquarters.

Note 3: For Mandatory boards (ANG & AFR), a Senior Rater can request an earlier pin on date (IAW AFI 36-2504, Chapter 6) if officer is the incumbent in the higher graded billet and meets all other eligibility requirements.

## How to Help Yourself Get Promoted Continued

- Developmental Education is a must and complete it as soon as possible
  - Make sure it is updated in records; ensure your supervisor knows
- Ensure your OPRs are well-written
  - Show mission accomplishment/impact and ranking if possible
  - Provide draft to supervisor at least one month prior to close-out
  - Completed on time and check PRDA for completed/filed eval, make copy
  - If a report is late, send a MyPers message with the Board ID in the subject and the EVR number in the message so they can manually update your OPR
- Ensure duty titles are appropriate/show progression
  - Past duty titles can be updated by submitting past OPRs through vPC
  - Current duty titles are updated by submitting an AF FM 2096 to the detachment
    - Must be within evaluation period, not past
    - Duty title can only have 30 characters, which includes spaces
    - Duty titles are tied to the position/DAFSC
- Ensure satisfactory participation a good R/R year



## How to Help Yourself Get Promoted Continued

- Review Officer Pre-selection Brief (OPB) as soon as you get it
  - Take corrective actions ASAP; follow instructions and follow-up
  - Ask MPS/A1/J1 for OPB/DQHB to ensure corrective actions are reflected.
- Respond to eOSR audit request ASAP
- "You will not be considered by a SSB if, in exercising reasonable diligence, you should have discovered an error or omission in your record and could have taken corrective action"
- Know PRF deadline every command/unit is different
- Discuss PRF or promotion eligibility with supervisor; offer draft to supervisor; need supporting documentation (PRF worksheet)
- Be knowledgeable as you may be teaching your supervisor and chain of command;
   be ready with AFI/ARPCM
- Reserve PRFs do NOT have a quota for Definitely Promotes
- Senior raters owe officer a copy of PRF a month before the board
- Evaluate need for letter to the board
  - Get advice from senior officer/previous board member

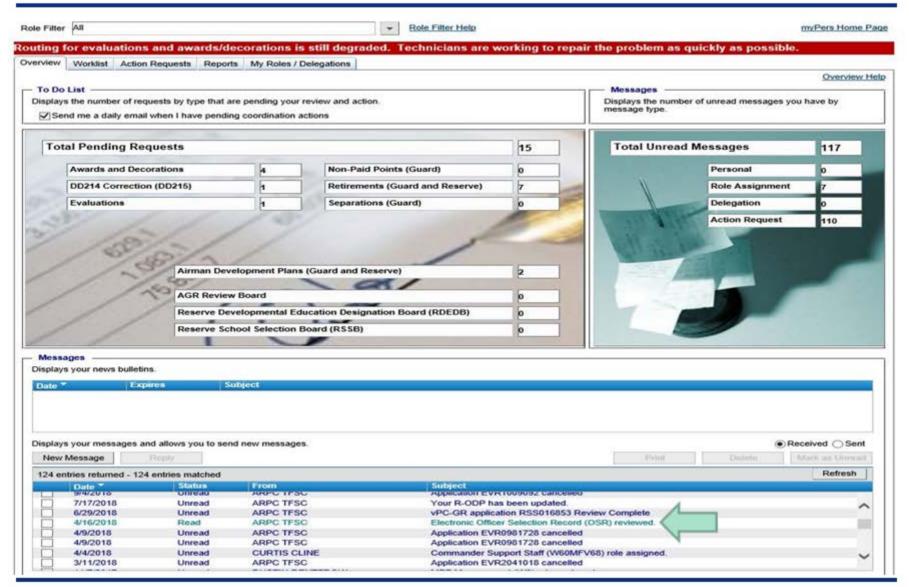

## Officer Selection Record

- The OSR is the documents that are provided to selection board for review to include:
  - Promotion Recommendation Form (PRF)
  - All officer's performance and training reports, filed in chronological order; the most recent reports on top (including gap reports for breaks in service)
  - Citations or orders for approved decorations
  - Board certification for health professions officers
  - Letter to the board submitted by member
  - Court-Martial, Article 15 or Letter of Reprimand (LOR) documentation filed by proper authority
- Electronic OSR Audit Results (eOSR)
  - Audited by ARPC Total Force Service Center
  - Identify any Eval or Dec discrepancies found between the MilPDS, PRDA and the member's OSR.
  - eOSR is accessed through the vPC Dashboard, https://gumcrm.csd.disa.mil/app/processes/form/fn/vdb under the "Worklist" tab
- MilPDS, PRDA and the OSR should all have the same information

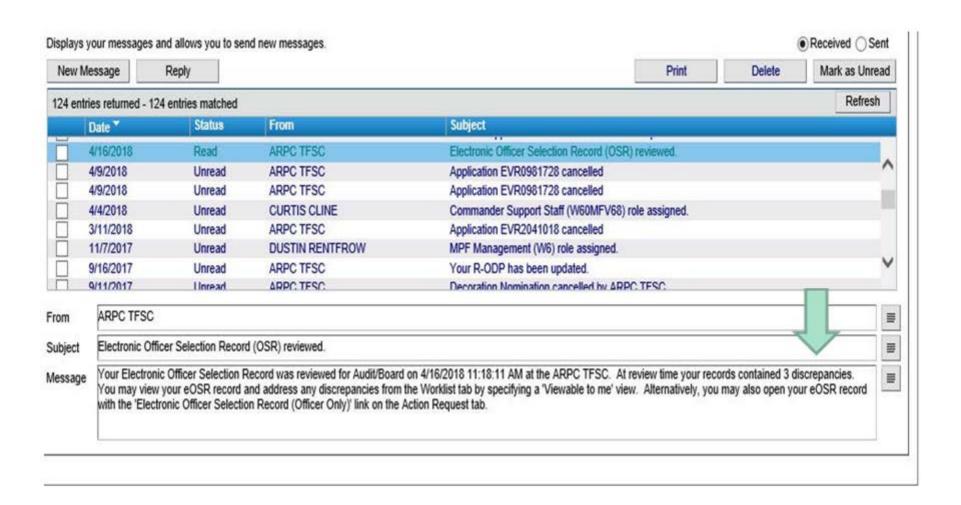


## Viewing eOSR Discrepancies

## Letters To The Board



- Purpose: To communicate to the promotion board, calling attention and/or providing an explanation of deficiencies, missing items, gaps in participation or other matters germane to promotion consideration
- Possible reasons for submitting a letter to the promotion board include, but are not limited to:
  - Break in service (what were you doing during your break. i.e. pursuing education, dealing with a family illness, etc)
  - Current or recent assignment in a nonparticipating status (reasons for and if seeking a participating assignment)
  - Insufficient active or inactive duty tour points or points for retirement, especially in recent years (explain)
  - Lack the appropriate level of developmental education (currently enrolled)
  - Mention any specific achievements not mentioned in Officer Performance Reports (OPRs) or in the selection folder
- More guidance on myPers
- Submit letters electronically through vPC

Way Ahead: Refocus PRF narrative on potential



### WHY:

- Focus on potential to serve in the next higher grade vice creative writing style and format
- Enhance senior rater voice to the promotion board, as originally intended

### SUMMARY OF MAJOR CHANGES:

- Comments limited to 2-lines max in bullet format
- DE and job/assignment pushes are not authorized
- Formalized PRF stratification guidance

# U.S. AIR FORCE

## PRF Comments Guidance

- PRF comments are limited to a <u>maximum of 2-lines</u> in bullet or narrative format
- In these comments, the senior rater should provide a performance-based differentiation and/or characterization of the eligible officer's potential to serve in the next higher grade
  - Said differently—This is an opportunity for the senior rater to tell the Central Selection Board why they should (or should not) promote this officer
  - Comments should not be a summary of information already contained in the record of performance (i.e. a regurgitation of past stratifications, awards, accomplishments)
- Endorsements for promotion are based upon an officer's demonstrated character and competence
- Comments or pushes for items that are decided through other processes or means (e.g. developmental education, jobs, assignments) are not authorized

# U.S. AIR FORCE

## PRF Stratification Guidance

- Definition: Officer stratification is a quantitative comparison of an individual's standing within an authorized peer group and within a specific evaluator's scope of rating authority
  - On the PRF, officer stratification statements provide a current performance-based differentiation of officers against their peers to assist Central Selection Boards

### Stratification Types:

- Primary Eligible by Zone. Senior raters may stratify amongst eligible officers by promotion zone (e.g. I/APZ and BPZ) from the Master Eligibility List (MEL) for a specific promotion board (Example: #3/10 I/APZ eligible, #1/17 BPZ eligible)
- Secondary Peer Group Stratification. <u>IF</u> a senior rater stratifies an officer amongst eligible officers by promotion zone, <u>THEN</u> they may also provide one peer group stratification in accordance with the guiding principles



## PRF Stratification Guidance Continued

- Authorized Peer Groups: for the purposes of stratification, authorized peer groups are limited to the following categories:
  - AF Grade: Includes only Air Force officers in the same grade (e.g. Captains, Majors, Lieutenant Colonels, Colonels)
  - Command Position: This refers to officers filling command positions (e.g. detachment, squadron, group, or wing commanders and materiel leaders)
    - Command position stratification statements for individuals below O-6 may also include their grade with the stratification statement (i.e. #2/6 Maj Sq/CCs)
  - Duty Position: This refers to the officer's duty position type, level and scope of responsibility (e.g. section chiefs, flight commanders, operations officers, branch chiefs, action officers, analysts, instructors, combat systems officers, pilots, etc.)



## PRF Stratification Guidance Continued

- Scope of Authority: Senior raters can only stratify officers within the confines of their direct rating chain and knowledge—senior rater stratification statements may not extend beyond the confines of their respective senior rater ID (SRID) or overall purview
- Authorized Usage:
  - When used, all stratification statements must stay within an authorized peer group and the evaluator's scope of authority
  - Stratification statements must be written in quantitative terms
    - Examples:
      - By AF Grade: "#3/30 Capts"; "#1/1 Majs"; "#2/12 Lt Cols"
      - By Command Position: "#1/9 Grp/CCs", "#1/7 Maj Sq/CCs"; "#3/20 Lt Col Det/CCs"
      - By Duty Position: "#1/6 Flt/CCs"; "#1/40 Analysts"; "#2/12 Branch Chiefs"



## PRF Stratification Guidance Continued

## Prohibited Usage

- Company Grade Officers (CGOs) and/or Field Grade Officers (FGOs) are not an authorized peer group for stratification purposes
- Officers may not be stratified based on additional duty positions and may not be stratified against enlisted personnel
- Stratification statements based on awards are not authorized (e.g. #1/50 as Sq CGO of the Quarter)
- Use of stratification statements from anyone other than the senior rater are prohibited
  - a senior rater may not quote stratification from another evaluator or source



# **Examples of 2-Line PRF Comments**

#### Intent:

- Focus on potential to serve in the next higher grade vice creative writing style/format
- Enhance senior rater voice to the promotion board, as originally intended
- Considerations (not all inclusive)—the officers experience, capabilities, character, competence, or recent performance not yet captured in the record
- Seasoned leader with diverse experiences--PME instructor, proven COCOM/HAF staff officer, and Iraq/Korea tours #3/14 I/APZ eligibles & #16/113 O-4s; highlytrusted and proven leader we need as an O-5--Definitely Promote
- Phenomenal FSS/DO; sync'd unit readiness/base reception/NEO--propelled team to '18 PACAF Ops Prgm of Year!
- #1/2 I/APZ eligibles; #2/10 Sq/DOs in wing; dynamic leader with boundless talent the AF needs--a must for Lt Col
- One of my very best--truly outstanding SFS/CC who puts people first; thinks, leads, and performs well above peers
- #1/17 BPZ eligibles; #2/9 Maj Sq/CCs; Definitely Promote this exemplary leader--grit, drive, diligence...unmatched!

Again, this is an opportunity for the senior rater to tell the Central Selection Board why they should (or should not) promote this officer—unconstrained by 'style' and 'codes'

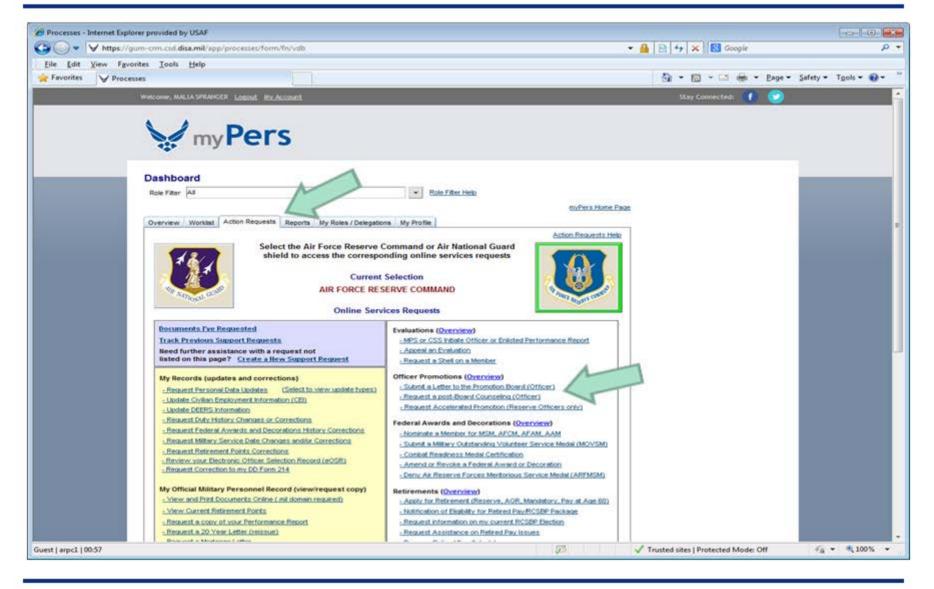


# Special Selection Boards

- Administrative error (i.e., missed a board, otherwise eligible to meet)
- Legal or material error (i.e., missing documents performance reports, citations, etc.)
- Approved formal appeal through an Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records (AFBCMR) or Evaluation Report Appeal Board (ERAB)
- Applicants will not be considered for an SSB or SB if, by exercising reasonable diligence, the officer should have discovered the error or omission and could have taken corrective action before the originally scheduled board convened
- SSBs and SBs are scheduled as a result of <u>Post Board Counseling</u>, <u>AFBCMR</u>, or <u>ERAB</u>. <u>Officers with concerns should request post board counseling</u>.
- Should the review of the promotion selection record reveal any errors, as identified above, the officer will be advised of the next step to take to correct the record (i.e., AFBCMR, ERAB, etc). Once the record is corrected, staffing the SSB/SB consideration will begin

## CY 20 Reserve Officer Promotions

### Majors Board: 27 Jan - 1 Feb 2020

- Position vacancy time in grade is 5 years to pin on (DOR 30 Sep 2015)
  - PRF required for PV only; BDE completion is mandatory; satisfactory R/R year
  - Must be in Major's billet as primary, not overage
  - Ranked with other PV officers
- Mandatory board DOR 30 Sep 2014 or earlier...min time in grade is seven years to pin on
  - BDE completion required for "Definitely Promote"
  - No PRF required unless command has a "Do Not Promote"
  - Ranked with other Mandatory Board eligible officers

### Lt Cols Board: 8-13 Jun 2020

- Position vacancy DOR 1 Oct 2014 30 Sep 2015...min time in grade is 5 years to pin on
  - PRF required; IDE completion mandatory; satisfactory R/R year
  - Must be in Lt Col billet as primary, not overage
  - Ranked with other PV officers



# CY 20 Reserve Officer Promotions Continued

### Lt Cols Board: 8-13 Jun 2020 Continued

- Mandatory board DOR 30 Sep 14 or earlier...min time in grade is seven years to pin on
  - IDE completion required for "Definitely Promote"
  - PRF required
  - Ranked other Mandatory Board eligible officers
  - Number 1 of 2 DPs given of three officers eligible...1/2/3

Colonels Board: 19-24 Oct 2020

- Mandatory board DOR 30 Sep 14 or earlier...min time in grade is seven years to pin on
  - No position vacancy board; all meet same board
  - DOR 30 Sep 2016 or earlier...All meet with 4 years time in grade
  - SDE completion required for "Definitely Promote"
  - PRF required
  - Ranked by each senior rater
  - Number 1 of 2 DPs given of 3 officers eligible...1/2/3
  - Master's Degree unmasked visible to board members



# CY 20 Reserve Officer Promotions Continued

### Brigadier General Qualification Board: 3-6 Nov 2020

- Mandatory board DOR 30 Sep 14 or earlier...min time in grade is seven years to pin on
  - Not a promotion board; reservists can opt out
  - General Officer Qualification Recommendation Form used, AF Form 3559
