## Force Development Plan

- Force Development Designed to grow institutional & occupational competencies in all Airmen through education, training, & experience opportunities to satisfy current & future Air Force mission requirements
  - AFI 36-2640, Executing Total Force Development
  - AFRCI 36-2640, Executing AF Reserve Force Development
  - AFI 36-2301 Developmental Education
  - AFI 36-2254V2 Reserve Personnel Training



## AFR Developmental Education (DE)

- Previously known as Professional Military Education
- DE goes beyond Air University courses
  - Focuses on critical thinking & problem solving
  - Tactical, Operational, & Strategic level education
- Guiding Principles
  - Hone & enhance AF cultural awareness
  - Reinforce core values through exemplification
  - Integrate competency & expertise into Air/Space Ops
  - Hone joint & coalition understanding
  - Expand expertise through mentoring

- Blended (self-study/on-line&seminar)
  - Competitive selection process for IDE & SDE via 2<sup>nd</sup> offering of Reserve School Selection Board (RSSB)
- In-residence
  - Extremely competitive selection process for BDE/IDE/SDE via RSSB (BDE) & RDEDB (IDE & SDE)





- Conducted annually (convenes usually mid/late Oct)
  - Public release Usually mid Nov/early Dec
- In-residence courses
  - Operational (IDE) & Strategic (SDE) level
  - https://gumcrm.csd.disa.mil/app/answers/detail/a\_id/14250/p/16,17/c/549
- Limited quotas & extremely competitive
- Return on Investment Officer should be "placed" after school attendance, but be proactive on job search
- R-ODP / Rater & Senior Rater endorsements important
- Strong submission justification (i.e., vPC-GR application)
  - Focus on AF, COCOMS, & Defense Agency benefits


## AY 14/15 Board Considerations

- RDEDB Members use a compilation of the following to score applicants:
  - SURF with Decoration listing, Education, PME, Deployment History, etc.
  - OPRs
  - DT KPL
  - DT DE List
  - DT comments/vectors
  - Top 20% or PV promotion indicators
  - R-ODP
  - RDEDB Application
    - Is wording on application in line with wording on R-ODP?
    - Member can update R-ODP at any time as career goals change
  - Rater's Comments on Application
  - Senior Rater's Comments and Rack and Stack
- School placement is based on member's score and member's school preferences



## Suggestions for Success

- READ the Invitation to Apply THOROUGHLY
  - Know what you are applying for & tailor your justification & any supporting docs for the course requested
- Know your Chain of Command, specifically who
- Discuss with your Rater your intentions & let him/her know that this is of NO COST to your unit
  - AFRC funded
- Prepare justification statement for your Rater, CC, and/or Senior Rater (e.g., worksheet)
- Submit application to Rater ASAP prior to deadline
  - Reminder: Rater routed to RIO Det 6 CC by 22 Aug 16
- Routing chain: Member > Rater > RIO Det CC > Senior Rater > RIO Det CC > ARPC

- If course completion fails to reflect in your records, please take one of the following actions:
  - Officers must contact HQ Air University (HQ AU)/CFRO, at DSN 493 / Comm (334) 953-4776 or fax a written request to fax DSN 493 / Comm 953-8127.
    - In your message/fax, please include your first and last Name, SSN,
       E-mail Address, phone number, course ID and completion date
  - Enlisted members may provide their course completion certificates/document(s) to their Education & Training Manager/Office who will update the personnel records in the Military Personnel Data System (MiIPDS)
  - Civilian employees will take completed certificate(s) to their local Civilian Personnel Office
