

Reserve Categories





Selected Reserve Traditional Reserve (TR)

- Part-time Reservist assigned to a reserve unit
- As of Feb 2018, TRs comprise over 49,761 of all personnel assigned in the AFRC
- Category A
 - 48 UTAs and 14 days AT
- May volunteer for active duty orders or be mobilized to fill Air Force mission requirements as needed





Selected Reserve Air Reserve Technician (ART)

- ARTs carry a dual status
 - Full-time civil service employees
 - Military members in the same unit
- As of Jul 2018, ARTs consisted of 8,880 of all personnel assigned in AFRC
- Unique among DoD civil servants in that they wear their uniforms and utilize their rank at all times
 - Whether in civil service, drill or AD status
- Are subject to mobilization/recall
- Program first implemented in 1958 after an AF study showing Reservists and Guardsmen could be trained by fewer ARTs than by full-time AD personnel.
 - Saved the Air Force \$13 million (in 1958 \$USD) during its first year of operation.



Selected Reserve Individual Mobilization Augmentee (IMA)

- Assigned directly to a Regular Air Force/Active Component unit.
- As of Feb 2018, IMAs consisted of 7,571 of all personnel assigned in AFRC
- Assigned to AF and COCOM missions in the U.S. and around the world
- Category B Reservist
 - 12 IDTs and 12 days AT
 - However, some specialized career fields/positions require 48 IDTs
- IMAs bring experience to the fight and help the active component accomplish its mission by:
 - Deploying with the unit
 - Backfilling positions vacated by AC members
 - Performing missions at their normal duty station as needed



- Most flexible participation status offered by the Air Force Reserve
- Bring specialized corporate knowledge from technical career fields in highly successful civilian companies and organizations
- May volunteer for active duty orders or be mobilized to fill Air Force mission requirements as needed
- IMAs are in the active component chain of command for their duty performance

Selected Reserve Active Guard Reserve (AGR)

- Active Guard Reserve (AGR) members who are ordered to full-time AD for the purpose of organizing, administering, recruiting, instructing, or training the reserve component units
- As of Feb 2018, AGRs comprise over 3,588 of all personnel assigned in the AFRC
- Career status vs single tour of duty





- PIRR (known as Category E) is a subset of the IRR, consists of Ready Reservists not in the Selected Reserve
- Assigned to ARPC but attached to AD organization
 - · Civil Air Patrol HQ at Maxwell AFB, AL
 - Admissions Liaison Officers assign to USAFA (Det 3)
- O6s in PIRR are managed by REG/AF
- May participate for points only; only MPA duty is paid
- Subject to AD recall by the President or Congress in time of national emergency or war



Individual Ready Reserve NNRPS-Non-Obligated Non-Participating Ready Personnel Section

- Consists of individuals who have had training and have previous experience in the Regular Component or the Selected Reserve
- Maintains status in IRR either voluntarily or because of a remaining military service obligation
- Members may NOT participate for pay or points
- Enlistment time and time in grade keeps ticking away







- Reservists are placed in this category if:
 - · Civilian job is considered "key employee"
 - Member has temporary disability
 - Member has personal hardship
- Most standby reservists do not train and are not assigned to units
- · 2% are on an "Active Status List"
 - May participate voluntarily without pay to earn retirement points
- Can be ordered to active duty only in time of war or national emergency, only with SECDEF approval



Retired Reserve (AFR and ANG)

- Reservist in this category are:
 - Reservist who have 20 years of satisfactory service
 - Waiting to turn age 60 to collect retirement pay ("Gray Area")
 - Are over 60 and receiving retirement pay
- Retired under special circumstances or for physical disabilities as determined by medical evaluation board
- SECAF may order to active duty if deemed necessary for national defense
 - If ordered to active duty, may be required to serve for an indefinite period of time
- Reduced Retired Pay Age active duty time served after 29 Jan 08 can decrease retirement eligibility age -More info in myPers


