

- An R/R (Retention/Retirement) year is the 12 consecutive months in which a reservist is required to accrue a minimum of 50 retirement points (including membership points) for a satisfactory year of service.
- 50 points = one "Good Year" for retirement







- Membership
 - 15 points
- Work
 - IDTs: one point per 4-hr period/max 2 per day
 - Pay & Points or Points-Only
 - AT/MPA/RPA: one point per day
- School/Training
 - In residence: one point per day
 - Distance learning: ECI points based on course hours completed – sometimes not applied until full course is done



Establishment of R/R date

- Everyone has a different R/R date
- Can be found on your PCARS (vMPF)
- For most when you entered the military
- Changes after a break in service



Can the R/R year be waived?

 By law, there is <u>no way to excuse or make-up</u> <u>points once R/R closes out.</u>

 The R/R training requirement was established by Title 10 U.S.C. 12642, 12732, 10147, and 8360 (d).





- DIFFERENT than R/R
- 1 Oct to 30 Sep same for everyone
- Annual Training (AT) is a minimum of 12 days used for individual and/unit readiness and training
- Inactive Duty Training (IDT) is a minimum 4 hour period of duty, training, or instruction
 - Each position requires either 24 or 48 four-hour periods
 - Maximum 130 four-hour periods per year (paid/non-paid IDTs)



Compare FY and R/R ...

FY Year

- Same for everyone
- Number of days or periods
- AT and IDT all that matters
- Keeps you in good standing
- Can be waived
- Tracked by the detachment

R/R Year

- Different for everyone
- Number of points
- All types of duty count for points
- Counts toward a reserve retirement
- Can't be waived
- Tracked by ARPC
 Points Management

 Branch




- IMAs unable to comply with FY minimum requirements may submit a waiver
- Waivers submitted and coordinated through your URC/Supervisor and approved by AD/CC & DET/CC
- Waivers may be submitted for the following reasons:
 - Substitution Waiver submitted and approved in advance and used only for AD tours which support contingency operation, real world, AEF missions or school tours
 - Excusal Waiver used for personal hardship or <u>extraordinary circumstance</u>

Requirement tracking highlights

- YOU have to keep track
 - If you only do the minimum, you'll have to track more closely
 - If you are doing school or go on orders, it's less of an issue
- Two SEPARATE things
 - R/R retirement qualification
 - FY required for your IMA job
- FY can be waived; R/R can NOT be waived



Update on Stop Movement

- Conditions-based guidance released two weeks ago
- First "green" state list released a few days ago
- Installation-level assessments not released yet
- Repository of info not yet known
- Defense.gov Newsroom
- When we know, we will tell you ASAP!



Options for Working during Stop Movement



Exception to Policy (ETP)

- Memo for approval by the first flag officer in your RegAF chain of command
- Allows you to travel for duty due to being "Mission Essential"
- Send to your Det when signed; orders writers will request it
- Template available on the COVID-19 SELRES UPDATE page of the HQ RIO website and on the RIO Connect app (click on the COVID-19 button)





- Work out a telecommute agreement with your RegAF unit
- Provide telecommute agreement to your detachment
- Blank agreement available on the COVID-19 SELRES UPDATE page of the HQ RIO website and on the RIO Connect app (click on the COVID-19 button)



Alternate Work Locations

- Do work for your unit at a nearby military installation
- Do work for ANOTHER unit at a nearby military installation -- RPA/MPA - earn points!
- Need a SCIF? Maybe there is one nearby you can use!







- There ARE options, but you might have to get creative
- If you're concerned about your FY
 - Check your PCARS
 - Get creative
 - Don't be afraid to ask!
 - If all else fails, submit for a waiver
- If you're concerned about your R/R year
 - Check your PCARS
 - Get creative
 - Don't be afraid to ask!
 - If all else fails, you'll have a bad year ... you'll recover
