Air Force Reserve Inactive Duty for Training Travel Reimbursement Guide - Fiscal Years (FY) 23/24

The purpose of this guide is to outline significant program entitlement changes for the remainder of FY23 and all of FY24. This guidance applies to the Air Force Reserve (AFR) Airmen and is intended to assist servicing Commander Support Staff (CSS), Military Personnel Flights (MPF) and Force Support Squadron (FSS) in understanding the “Air Force Reserve Inactive Duty for Training (IDT) Reimbursement” process.

IDT TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT GUIDE

1. INTRODUCTION:

Per the Joint Travel Regulation (JTR), the Secretary of the Air Force may authorize reimbursement of IDT travel reimbursement for members of the Selected Reserve (SelRes) requiring them to commute 150 or more miles for duty one-way when assigned to critically short Duty Air Force Specialty Codes (DAFSC), grade or manned unit. This also applies to units impacted by Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) actions.

As of 8 June 2023, the AFRC/CD approved a significant change in eligibility for the AFR IDT Travel Reimbursement program which immediately applies to the remainder of FY23 and will extend through FY24. Effective as of the date of this guide, all AFR Airmen with a grade of E1-E7 are eligible for IDT Travel Reimbursement. Airmen in the grade of E8-E9 as well as officers will remain eligible by critical DAFSC as established in the 1 May 23, version 4, *Air Force Reserve Inactive Duty for Training Travel Reimbursement Guide – FY23* (included here in section 5). The following provisions apply:

- The period of eligibility for this program starts on 8 June 2023 and expires on 30 September 2024.
- IDT travel reimbursement may be granted to eligible members who perform Unit Training Assemblies (UTAs), Readiness Management Periods (RMPs) and Additional Flying Training Periods (AFTPs).
- A reservist must possess the grade of E1-E7 or be assigned to an authorization (position number) with a DAFSC identified as eligible in this guide, to include wing of assignment if identified as by-location, and meet all other JTR and AFR eligibility criteria. This includes members assigned to Geographically Separated Units (GSUs) assigned/attached to eligible wings identified in this guide.
- The AFR IDT Travel Reimbursement program is subject to review and change based on AFR mission requirements, budget forecasts, and program execution.

6. TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT PAYMENT PROCEDURES

- IDT travel reimbursement is limited to 12 round trips per FY and reimbursement payments will not exceed \$500 per round trip.
- Mileage reimbursement will be paid according to the “Other Mileage” rate identified by the Defense Travel Management Office.
- Other eligible non-mileage reimbursements include: tolls (highway, bridge and tunnel), parking fees, rental car (travel days only), overnight lodging as required (travel days only), actual cost of meals including tips and taxes but excluding alcoholic beverages, up to the maximum locality meal rate (travel days only), and lodging taxes as applicable.
- Receipts are required for reimbursement of meals, overnight lodging costs to/from IDT, and non-mileage transportation costs (i.e. airport parking). Per Joint Travel Regulation (JTR), receipts are not required for highway/road tolls as long as none of the individual claimed tolls exceeds \$75 without a receipt.

7. MILEAGE RATES

Mileage rates may change each year.

Reference the “Other Mileage Rate” to verify the mileage rate for IDT travel by personal vehicle.

8. PREPARATION OF TRAVEL ORDERS (FOR ORDERS CLERKS)

Prior to preparing orders, confirm member is traveling for the IDT period(s) first to avoid over obligating unit RPA funds. If member does not travel, the obligated funds for the order created will not be executed, eliminating the ability for these funds to be used for other wing programs.

- For Individual Mobilized Augmentees (IMAs) contact your respective RIO Det for IDT travel order guidance.
- For Traditional Reservists IDT travel outside normal commute will be accomplished using DD Form 1610, Request and Authorization for TDY Travel of DoD Personnel. Prepare the IDT outside normal commute order in the Air Force Order Writing System (AROWS-R) using the following instructions:
 - Select order type: “Temporary Duty”
 - Select TDY purpose: “IDT Outside Normal Commute”

- Add Non-standard paragraph: “Member is assigned & performing in (insert grade) or DAFSC (insert DAFSC) which has been verified and member meets eligibility in accordance with the FY23/FY24 IDT Travel Reimbursement Guide. Member is authorized travel expenses NTE \$500 for round trip travel to and from Inactive Duty Training according to JTR, Paragraph 032304.”
- Ensure the funding line attached to the order has an **ESP Code of IH**.
- Upon completion of IDT travel, ensure the member files a travel voucher with supporting documents for payment of authorized reimbursable expenses IAW JTR and finance requirements.

9. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1: Who approved the IDT Travel Reimbursement program?

A1: It was approved by Congress as part of the FY08 NDAA, specifically Public Law 110-181.

Q2: What is the reference which supports travel reimbursement for IDT outside normal commute?

A2: JTR, paragraph 032304 and section 452 (b) (9) of Title 37 United States Code (U.S.C.) Effective date of this entitlement for Air Force Reserve personnel is 14 Aug 08.

Q3: Who is included in SelRes?

A3: They are members in an active status in the Air Force Reserve.

Q4: Who is eligible for this reimbursement?

A4: Effective 8 June 2023, all E1-E7 (by member current grade) are eligible for this program. Airmen in the grade of E8-E9 as well as officers will remain eligible by critical DAFSC as established in the 1 May 2023, version 4, *Air Force Reserve Inactive Duty for Training Travel Reimbursement Guide – FY23* (included in section 5 of this guide). This includes members assigned to GSUs assigned/attached to eligible wings identified in this guide.

Q5: Does IDT travel reimbursement eligibility apply to points only IDTs?

A5: Yes, if the member is eligible for IDT travel reimbursement and they travel to the IDT location, they would be authorized reimbursement for their travel even if they are receiving a points only IDT.

Q6: If an eligible member is on long-term orders and travels to IDT, is the member authorized IDT travel reimbursement?

A6: No, as they are not in IDT status. AFMAN 36-2136 para 4.3 states: Reservists assigned to the Selected Reserve and in an Active Duty for Operational Support status are considered constructively present for scheduled training, regardless whether they are physically present or not.

Q7: Does IDT travel reimbursement eligibility apply to Developmental & Training Flight (D&TF) and/or 1-skill level members?

A7: Yes, effective 8 June 2023, all E1-E7 (by member current grade) are eligible for this program, regardless of skill level; however, please note these members often do not have a Government Travel Card (GTC).

Q8: If a prefix or shred is listed, does that mean the core DAFSC still qualifies?

A8: No the core five-digit DAFSC (example: 3P0X1 or 4N0X1) would not qualify. The Career Field Manager/MAJCOM Functional Manager (CFM/MFM) has identified a specific skill set within the AFSC to incentivize (example X4N0X1).

Q9: If only the DAFSC is listed, does that mean the prefix or shred would still qualify?

A9: Yes, as long as it's only listed as the DAFSC in the guide, then the prefix and shred would qualify as well. *As stated in question 8, if only the prefix or shred are listed in the guide, then the DAFSC alone would not qualify. (example X4N0X1).*

Q10: Are local commute policy letters required from installation commanders?

A10: No, mileage for IDT travel reimbursement eligibility is determined by Defense Table of Official Distance (DTOD). Members must live outside 150+ miles from their home station according to DTOD and meet all other program eligibility criteria in order to receive IDT travel reimbursement.

Q11: Are members authorized reimbursement for a rental car?

A11: Yes, per JTR, rental car costs may be reimbursed for days used to travel to and from IDT. However, reimbursement is not authorized for in-place IDT days. For instance, a member can rent a car and drive to IDT on a Friday, perform UTA on Saturday- Sunday and then drive home Sunday. In this case, the member could be reimbursed for the cost of the rental car on Friday and Sunday but not Saturday.

Q12: If a member is promoted from E7 to E8, are they eligible?

A12: Members maintain eligibility if their DAFSC in the new grade is on the critical skills eligibility list in section 5 of this guide. If the DAFSC as an E8 is not listed, they are no longer eligible.

Q13: If an E8 is eligible based on their DAFSC list in section 5 of this guide, and then they are promoted to E9 and their new DAFSC is not listed; do they maintain eligibility?

A13: If a member is promoted into a new DAFSC that is not listed on the critical skills eligibility list, then they are not eligible for IDT travel reimbursement per this guide. For example, member is E8 in DAFSC 4N091, then promotes to E9 into DAFSC 4N000, the member is no longer eligible for the IDT travel reimbursement program.

10. PROGRAM HISTORY

Date	Event
14 Aug 08	Air Force Reserve Command Inactive Duty Training Outside Normal Commute Distance program established.
1 Jan 19	Eligibility increased from \$300 to \$500 per round trip. Members are authorized reimbursement for up to 12 round trips per calendar year. This is an annual limitation only. Reimbursement is authorized for multiple round trips in a given month.
1 Jan 20	Individual Reservist with designated DAFSCs are eligible to receive IDT Travel Reimbursement for duty performed at identified JRIC locations.
