COLONEL KIRA C. COOPER

Colonel Kira Cooper is the Commander, Headquarters Readiness and Integration Organization, Detachment 7 at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling in which she manages Individual Reserve matters for assigned members in the National Capital Region. She recently served on the Joint Staff J-1, Manpower and Personnel Directorate, after graduating from the Eisenhower School, in which she earned a master's degree in National Resource Strategy with a concentration in Financial Management at Fort McNair in Washington, D.C.

Colonel Cooper earned her commission through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps at Tennessee State University in May 2003 and continued to serve in the active component for 8 years. She completed her initial assignment at Cannon Air Force Base, NM. During her tenure, Second Lieutenant Cooper served as the Officer-in-Charge of the 374th Civil Engineer Squadron's Commander's Support Staff; a Squadron Adjutant for the 522d Fighter Squadron; and an Executive Officer for the 27th Operations Group. From 2006 to 2009, First Lieutenant Cooper was stationed at Yokota Air Base, Japan in which she served as a Section Commander for the Air Force's second largest Communications squadron; the wing's Military Equal Opportunity Chief; and led a 180-member Sustainment Services flight. In May 2008, she had the unique opportunity to deploy in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM to Guantanamo Bay, Cuba as the Officer-in-Charge of the Joint Personnel Reception Center. In October 2009, she was reassigned to Headquarters, Air Force Special Operations Command (AFSOC) at Hurlburt Field, FL as the Chief of Support Officer Assignments.

In May 2011, Captain Cooper transitioned into the Air Force Reserve and remained at AFSOC as the 23d Air Force/A3 Executive Officer. In October 2012, she became the Air Force Reserve Service Liaison Officer to the Defense Equal Opportunity Management Institute at Patrick Air Force Base, FL. Her assignment was curtailed due to her selection to attend Air Command and Staff College in-residence at Air University in Maxwell Air Force Base, AL. Following her school tour, she moved to Atlanta, GA to become the Operations Officer for the Air Force Reserve Command's (AFRC) Eastern Recruiting Region. Major Cooper transitioned to the AFRC at Robins AFB, GA when she was selected to a key position as the Chief of Force Development within the Directorate of Manpower, Personnel, and Services. She was responsible for advising and translating Department of Defense, USAF, and USAFR policies and decisions into workable plans of actions. Subsequently, she was elevated to the Chief of Force Management, a new position added to the A1 Directorate, to lead the command's military personnel programs. While at AFRC, Lieutenant Colonel Cooper was the only Force Support Officer selected to command on active duty in 2019. She graduated command of the 87th Force Support Squadron at Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, NJ in which she was directly responsible for leading 1.4K active duty personnel in providing customer-focused activities and programs that enhance the quality of life for 88 mission partners spread across 42,000 acres.
